Local Area Focus: Immediate Local Area

Year 3

Roman Invasions of Britain topic: We will develop our mapping skills, explore types of settlement and trade links across Britain.

The Vikings are coming topic: We will study European human and physical geography and how this can affect the land use of different settlements.

The Ancient Mayas topic: Comparing Amazon and UK biomes.
