Communication & language

This half term the children will be getting to know their new friends. This is done by encouraging talk during carpet and learning time and all about me bags. We will also be learning lots of nursery rhymes and action songs. The story we will focus on is 'Rosie's Walk' this will include talking about 'who' is in the story. We will then orally sequence the story to make a class story map.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will have a big focus on friendships. How to make new friends, learning their names and sharing when playing alongside others.

Physical Development

We will begin our weekly PE sessions in the hall on Mondays. We will be developing our spatial awareness playing lots of stop and go games, making sure we do not bump into anyone. Literacy

This half term we will be developing our listening and attention skills, exploring environmental sounds around us. We will go on a listening walk in school and around our outside area to see what different sounds we can hear. When sharing stories we will think about 'who' is in the story and 'what' has happened.

Mathematical Development

This half term we will begin by singing lots of number rhymes and rote counting to 5. We will begin to represent numbers 1-5 using our fingers.
