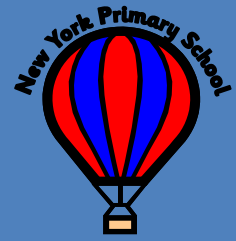


Summer Term 2019- Year 1

Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch

English

This term we will be learning the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' as a Talk for Write. We will complete a range of written activities including writing a postcard to Mrs Grinling about the scavenging seagulls.

We will be linking Mr Grinling's old sea shanties to poetry, looking at rhyming couplets.

With the phonics screener getting closer we will be practising our Read Write Inc sounds and reading lots of alien words.

History

In history this term, we will be learning the story of local heroine Grace Darling. We will be looking at the Victorians and comparing life in Victorian times to modern day life including what day to day life was like and what people did for fun.

Music

This term we will be using Charanga 'Your Imagination' to explore composing songs using our own imagination. We will also learn some sea shanties.

Mathematics

This term we will be working on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables and using our knowledge to problem solve.

We will be looking at measuring mass in kilograms and grams as well as looking at volume and capacity.

We will also be looking at $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ fractions of an object and an amount using real life examples.

RE/PSHCE

This half term in R.E. we will be looking at bible stories including the story of creation.

In PSHCE we will be looking at relationships. We will be looking at how we change as we get older and our families.

Science

This term we will be looking at seasonal changes. We will discuss how the weather changes across seasons and how day length varies.

We will also be looking at light including sources of light and how shadows are formed. We will create our own shadow puppets. We will also undertake a range of investigations to expand our scientific enquiry.

Computing

This term we will be using Purple Mash to create a multimedia story of Grace Darling's life. We will explore adding different effects such as animation, sound and further develop our typing skills.

Art/DT

As part of our seaside topic we will create different types of sea creatures using different materials and textures.

PE

This term we will be improving our bat and ball skills, we are hoping for some nice weather to play ball games outside including rounders! To keep us active during the day we will use Go Noodle and BBC super movers.
