

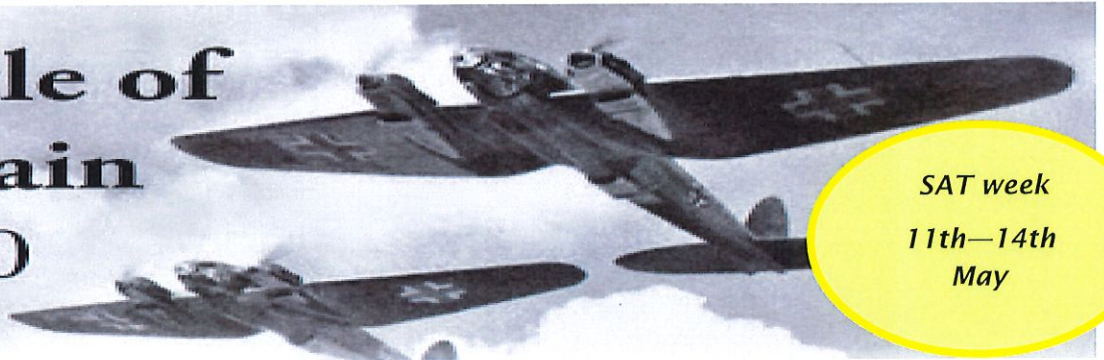

THE SATS ARE COMING!

English

As we lead up to the SATS children will write, edit, improve and complete final pieces of writing to ensure they have a portfolio of work. We shall use this term's texts — 'Machine Gunners' and 'The Battle of Britain' as a stimulus for their writing. Children will revise all areas of grammar and punctuation to ensure they are confident in using them in writing. Finally children will complete many comprehension exercises in timed conditions to prepare them for the Reading SAT.

Computing

This term children will be learning how to edit videos and communicate effectively in their computing lessons. We will also have weekly Mathematics lessons, and time on Spelling Shed.

Science

Our Science topics this term will be 'Light' investigating how it travels followed by living things in their habitats.

Mathematics

Throughout this term children will revisit and advance their skills within:

- Calculations
- Handling Data
- Measuring
- Understanding Shape
- Using and applying maths

We will also carry out extensive practice recalling our existing knowledge of arithmetic facts in preparation for the SAT test.

History/Geography

Throughout the term, our creative curriculum will make links to our English text. Children will improve their knowledge of World War 2 through the study of the Battle of Britain. The children will look at how Britain and our local area were physically affected.

Music

Children will be exploring notation. They will learn how scales are used and how to correctly write notes on the scale.

Art/DI

We will be linking our art lessons to our creative curriculum where children will use a range of media to draw and illustrate landscapes inspired by famous artist Sir William Orpen.

PE

This term children will be focussing on improving their skills in dance as well as taking part in striking and fielding lessons. They will also continue to increase stamina by running the daily mile.

RE/PSHE

We will be learning about the importance of worship in Hinduism religion. We will also be learning about the Christian celebration of Easter, alongside our study of Buddhism.

In PSHE we will be looking at different influences that we might encounter such as peer pressure and the effects of drugs and alcohol.
