

Communication & language

We will learn the story of 'Jasper's Beanstalk' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and we will create our own story maps which will help us to retell the story. We will then innovate the story.

We will also begin to use past, present and future tense when talking about events that have happened or are going to happen.

Spend lots of time practising the story of Jack and the Beanstalk using the story map that we will send home.

This half term we will be learning to retell the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. As a class we will begin to write simple words and sentences, ensuring we include capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will begin to think about the beginning, middle and end of the story.

When reading we will continue use our good story telling voices.

Mathematical Development

This half term we continue to develop our understanding of addition and subtraction. In our measure work we will be measuring our beanstalks and looking at the difference in growth.

Understanding the World

During our woodlands visits we will be looking at changes to the environment. We will be looking at growth and change over time with the help of tadpoles from the pond and chicks. We will observe the changes that happen from frogspawn to Frog.
