Communication & language

We will be learning about rhyme by looking at objects that sound the same and playing different games (rhyming pairs and bingo). Who is special to you?


Physical Development

We have weekly PE sessions in the hall on Mondays. We will be developing our spatial awareness playing lots of stop and go games, making sure we do not bump into anyone. We will also be practising ring games (duck, duck goose) and dancing to improve our gross motor skills.

Literacy

This half term we will be supporting children to stay engaged throughout a story, join in with repeated phrases and select books independently and locate aspects of interest within the pages.



Mathematical Development

This half term we will be representing numbers in different ways. For example dice, pictures, fingers, cubes. We are beginning to recognise numerals to 10. We will also be learning to recognise and name 2D shapes.

Understanding the World

This half term we will be exploring freezing and melting. (ice experiment adding salt, food colouring, warm water and discuss the changes. We will also look at a features of a map and discussing different countries (warm and cold).
