Les Animaux - adjectives of colours and size. Masculine, feminine and plural nouns.

Mon Anniversaire - numbers, time, months, seasons, weather and poetry.

Le Monde - Describing countries and towns orally and in writing and using directions.

The use of French grammar, including masculine and feminine forms, begins in Year 3 and progresses throughout the school.

Children learn about French culture, traditions and festivals throughout the academic year.

Mon Ecole et Moi - school subjects and routines, telling the time and giving detailed opinions.

A manger et a boire Ordering food and drinks in a café and learning about healthy and unhealthy eating.

Les Sports - sporting activities and opinions.

Year 3

Je Parle Français - Developing some basic vocabulary skills including a range of greetings and numbers to 12.

Je Me Presente - Key phrases to talk about yourself and ask about others.

Ma Famille - Learning key vocabulary for talking about family members.

Les Vetements - Shopping for, and describing, clothes.

J'habite - Using prepositions to describe your home and local area.

Un Pays Francophone - Learning about the culture of a French speaking country - St Lucia.

EYFS and KSI
