This term we will be labelling animals and writing captions to describe different animals found in the woods. We will learn the story of Little Red Riding Hood using Talk 4 Writing and complete other writing activities based around the story. During Autumn 2 we will continue to build on our Literacy skills, completing descriptive writing linked to our key text. We will continue to practise our Read Write Inc sounds and reading lots of alien words.

Geography

In Geography this term, we will study the school grounds and our local area. We will explore map making and compare our local area with other places.

History

In History this term we will learn about the work of Grace Darling and how she had had an impact on modern day life. We will carry out a local study of the TVLB and look at the sinking of SS Stanley.

PSHE/RSHE

This term we will be settling into Year I routines, learning all about new beginnings and being able to identify trusted adults. We will also explore feelings and friendships.

Mathematics

This term we will be expanding our mathematical basic skills including number formation, presentation and use of resources to support our learning. We will further develop our number knowledge and will count forwards and backwards to 50 and from a given number. We will find one more and one less, read and write numbers 1-20 in numerals and words and extend our mathematical vocabulary.

Music

This term we will be using Charanga and all the learning is focused around one song: 'Hey, You!' We will learn the pulse, rhythm and pitch through games and playing instruments.

RE

We will be looking at 'What it means to belong' and the importance of family. We will begin to look at Christianity and some of their traditions and celebrations including Harvest and Christmas. We will listen to stories from the Bible to learn more about how the world began.

ΡΕ

This term we will be travelling in a range of different ways using equipment to help us to balance. We will create our own gymnastic sequences. We will also be focusing on throwing and catching.

Science

This term we will be looking at the human body and our senses. We will be learning which body part helps us to hear, see, smell, taste and touch. We will also label the human body.

We will also learn about different materials and what objects are made from. We will carry out simple experiments to test materials.

Computing

This term we will be learning how to log on and off the laptops. We will learn how to keep ourselves safe whilst using the internet as well as exploring digital sound.

Art

This term we will be looking at natural art using resources from our school ground. We will develop our sketching techniques, taking inspiration from artists.

DT

This term we will learn how to roll, cut, fold and bend materials to create an under the sea creature. We will develop these skills further to produce Christmas crafts.
