


## Spring Term 2024


# Year I - Bears and Owls

#### English

This term we will be looking at the adventures of Flat Stanley. We will be practising our descriptive writing as well as developing new vocabulary. We know Flat Stanley loves a kite so we will make our own and write instructions for Reception. During Spring 2 we will use verbs and suffixes to enhance our writing. As Year I phonics screener approaches we will be practising our Read Write Inc sounds and reading lots of nonsense monster words!

### Geography

In Geography we will be comparing the features of our local environment with the many different countries that Flat Stanley has visited throughout his exciting adventures around the world.

#### History

This half term we will be learning all about Mary Anning and her fossil discoveries. We will compare how life in Georgian times differs to the modern day.

#### **PSHE**

In PSHE we will be discussing who helps us when we are unwell and how we can feel better. We will also be discussing how to stay safe around medicine.

#### **Mathematics**

This term we will be working on our addition and subtraction within 20. We will continue with our place value skills, working with numbers up to 50 and time tables including multiples of 2,5 and 10. We will be learning how to use rulers and look at how we measure in centimetres. We will also measure capacity and volume.

#### Music

This half term Year I will be using Charanga to explore pulse and rhythm.

We will also learn a range of songs from around the world!

#### RΕ

This term will be continuing to learn about Christianity. We will learn more about the religion including the Easter story and the importance of Jesus to Christians.

#### Art

In Art we will design our own clay fossil. We will design and make it. We will also paint them before evaluating each others creations.

#### DT

In DT this half term we will be looking at where our food comes from. We will learn to chop, grate and peel safely before preparing a simple dish.

#### Science

In Science we will be identifying and sorting different types of animals. We will discuss what they eat and the features of different animal types.

We will also work scientifically, looking at the role of a palaeontologist—linking to Mary Anning. We will observe changes over time and begin to ask simple questions.

#### PΕ

We will be developing our dance skills by completing a range of balances, rolls and movements. We will incorporate these into an individual routine and a larger group routine.

We will also develop our cognitive movements to improve mobility, linking this to health related fitness.

#### Computing

In computing we will be creating a multimedia story of Flat Stanley's adventures. We will explore adding different effects such as animation, sound and further develop our typing skills.

We will begin our First Lego League missions, exploring this years theme. We will complete various challenges throughout the term.
