# English

In English this half term, children will write, edit, improve and complete final pieces of writing. We shall use this terms text — 'Street Child' as a stimulus for our writing, in genres such as biographies and persuasive narratives. Children will revise all areas of grammar and punctuation to ensure they are confident in using them in writing.

#### Computing

Children will be learning how to be safe on the internet, and when to spot something that is harmful to them. They will also have time each week on the iPads to use Reading Plus and arithmetic websites.

#### Science

Science this term will include investigations into inheritance and evolution. Children will be learning how humans and other living things have adapted over time, and will look at characteristics that living things either inherit or acquire from their parents.

## **Mathematics**

Throughout this term children will revisit and advance their skills within number, data, measure and shape. We will have a focus on reasoning and problem solving as well as carrying out extensive practice recalling our existing knowledge of arithmetic facts.

#### <u>History</u>

Throughout the half term, our

history curriculum will make links to our English text. Children will improve their knowledge of The Victorians through our big question 'How did Tyneside change during the Industrial Revolution?' The children will look at how Britain and our local area changed under Queen Victoria's reign.

#### **Erench**

This half term we will begin our topic of 'Les Vetements'. We will be looking at clothes, descriptive language and forming extended sentences in French.

#### DΤ

In DT, we will be looking at the work of William Morris. We will identify the features of the wallpaper he designed, before beginning to design our own using a success criteria. for block printing. Our final wallpaper will be presented in a sample book!

# PΕ

This term in PE, children will have the apportunity to develop their teamwork and invasion skills through hockey. They will also work on their gymnastics skills.

### RE/PSHE

In PHSE we will be looking at new beginnings and safety education including first aid.

In RE we will be exploring the beliefs of Islam, and how important it is to have religious diversity in an area.

#### Music

During music lessons this term the children will be focusing on musical notation and using this to play short songs on the keyboards.
